| 9 | Seventh-day Adventist Position Statement on Homosexuality |
| 10 11 | The Seventh-day Adventist Church recognizes that every human being is valuable in the |
| 12 | sight of God, and we seek to minister to all men and women in the spirit of Jesus. We also |
| 13 | believe that by God's grace and through the encouragement of the community of faith, an |
| 14 15 | individual may live in harmony with the principles of God's Word. |
| 16 | Seventh-day Adventists believe that sexual intimacy belongs only within the marital |
| 17 | relationship of a man and a woman. This was the design established by God at creation. The |
| 18 | Scriptures declare: "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his |
| 19 | wife, and they will become one flesh" (Gen 2:24, NIV). Throughout Scripture this heterosexual |
| 20 21 | pattern is affirmed. The Bible makes no accommodation for homosexual activity or relationships. Sexual acts outside the circle of a heterosexual marriage are forbidden (Lev 18:5-23, 26; Lev |
| 21 | 20:7-21; Rom 1:24-27; 1 Cor 6:9-11). Jesus Christ reaffirmed the divine creation intent: |
| 23 | "'Haven't you read,' he replied, 'that at the beginning the Creator "made them male and female," |
| 24 | and said, "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and |
| 25 | the two will become one flesh?" So they are no longer two, but one" (Matt 19:4-6, NIV). For |
| 26 | these reasons Seventh-day Adventists are opposed to homosexual practices and relationships. |
| 27 28 | Jesus affirmed the dignity of all human beings and reached out compassionately to |
| 28 29 | persons and families suffering the consequences of sin. He offered caring ministry and words of |
| 30 | solace to struggling people, while differentiating His love for sinners from His clear teaching |
| 31 | about sinful practices. As His disciples, Seventh-day Adventists endeavor to follow the Lord's |
| 32 33 | instruction and example, living a life of Christ-like compassion and faithfulness. |
